SUBJECT: FSFN Quarter 1 Release 'Go Live' for Senate Bill 80 Separated Sibling Assessment

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform child welfare stakeholders of recent enhancements to the Florida Safe Families Network (FSFN), deployed on **November 14, 2025**.

BACKGROUND:

The Department of Children and Families has completed development activities within the FSFN application to support the implementation of policy and practice changes associated with **Senate Bill 80 – Separated Sibling Assessment**. These enhancements have been thoroughly tested and are ready for release by the Office of Child and Family Well-Being.

This update is designed to improve how sibling placements are managed and documented in alignment with new legislative requirements. Key features of this release include:

1. **Standardized Documentation** – Ensures consistent recording of sibling placement decisions in Florida's Child Welfare Information System.
2. **Early Identification of Placement Options** – Promotes timely engagement of relatives and fictive kin as potential placement resources.
3. **Preservation of Sibling Connections** – Reinforces the importance of maintaining sibling relationships, while prioritizing each child's safety and well-being.
4. **Family Engagement Documentation** – Requires detailed documentation of efforts to locate and involve family members.
5. **Enhanced Performance Metrics** – Supports improved tracking and evaluation of:
 - Placement stability
 - Timeliness to permanency
 - Reentry into foster care
 - Child well-being indicators
